Canandaigua Country Club Hole- in- One Club

Rules - Effective November 1, 2014

A hole in one is a special event. Tradition calls for the golfer scoring the hole- in- one to purchase drinks for his/her golf partners and sometimes for all members in the clubhouse at the time of the event. Also, this special event will be added to our Hole-In-One Club stenciled on the wall inside the restaurant with your name, hole # and date. In order to make this a happy event for the golfer a new hole-in-one club has been formed to provide insurance to the hole-in-one golfer. Here are the rules of the club:

- To join each member must sign up in the Pro shop or contact Office Manager. You can pay the first deposit of \$3 or have it charged to your account. Both men and women are invited to participate.
- Each time a hole-in-one is made by a participating club member \$3 is automatically charged to each participant's club charge account (there is no need to re-sign up) in order to restore the fund for the next hole- in- one occurrence. The \$3 charge will appear on your month-end club statement. Remember it is possible that there could be more than one charge a month if there is more than one qualifying hole-in-one that month.
- A qualifying hole-in-one must be witnessed by the group playing with the golfer, or by another golfer(s) on the course. To be considered for payment under this program the event must also be confirmed by the Club Professional. This applies to only those scored at the Canandaigua Country Club course.
- The golfer scoring the hole- in- one is awarded the balance of the fund and may spend it in one of the following manners:
 - 1) Allow an "open bar" for a period of time (I.E. one hour, or until 5PM) or any other period of time, or until the balance is used up entirely.
- Canandaigua Country Club will participate to the extent of the Club Professional advising the business office of
 each hole-in-one event. The Club business office will then place a charge of \$3, against the account of each
 participant in order to restore the balance for the next hole-in-one event. They will also post the availability of
 the funds on the system for the benefit of the servers and bartenders.
- If a participating member no longer wishes to belong in the Hole- in- One Club they must notify the Club Professional, who will then notify the business office of the participant's withdrawal from the club. No more charges will be made to the member's account.
 - This is a project of the Hole-in-One club. Canandaigua Country Club accepts no liability regarding any dispute under this program.
- Since Steve Aronson had a hole-in-one in August, we need to start a new cycle, so for those previously had insurance, we assume that you would like to sign up again and will be charge the \$3 onto your account.
